

## Update Regarding Nursing License Expiration Dates

On October 7, 2020, the State Finance Council extended the State of Kansas COVID-19 Disaster Emergency Proclamation to November 15, 2020. Governor Kelly signed Executive Order No. 20-64 extending the renewal deadline for professional licenses during this state of Disaster Emergency. The Executive Order applies to nursing licenses that were in good standing as of March 12, 2020, and that have expired or will expire during the State of Disaster Emergency, which is currently set to expire on November 15, 2020. This means that the deadline to renew licenses that would otherwise expire during the State of Disaster Emergency is November 15, 2020.
