

Notice Regarding Extension of Licenses Pursuant to Executive Order 21-02

January 27, 2021

Governor Kelly signed Executive Order No. 21-02 on January 26, 2021 which extends certain executive orders relating to the COVID-19 pandemic. It extends Executive Order 20-39 which extends professional and occupational licenses during the state of disaster emergency. This Executive Order is re-issued and remains in effect until the Statewide State of Disaster Emergency extended by Senate Bill 14, enacted during the 2021 Legislative Session expires. Senate Bill 14 extended the State of Disaster emergency relating to COVID-19 through March 31, 2021.
