- C.N.E. Regulations: C. Moreland gave in update on the revisions being made to the C.N.E. Regulations 60-9-105, 60-9-106, and 60-9-107.
- IV-Therapy Task Force: C. Stephenson gave an overview on the survey that was sent out to the IV Therapy Providers. L. Owen and G. Gone would be interested in serving on the IV-Therapy Task Force.
- Delinquent Providers: C. Moreland gave an update on the Delinquent CNE Providers. Order Summaries will be sent to the six delinquent providers, who will have 15 days to request a hearing. At the end of those 15 days, if no hearing is requested, the providership will be withdrawn.

- National Credentialing Org.: A list of National Nursing Organizations was presented to the Committee. These organizations would be considered “pre-approved” if listed as a credentialing organization for CNE. It was moved to adopt the list of National Organizations for CNE providers.  - Kansas Department of Health & Environment – This provider is a current CNE Provider for the State of Kansas and therefore their application was tabled until March 2022.
