Call to order: The CNE & IV Therapy Committee meeting was called to order by Julianna Rieschick, RN, MSN, NEA-BC, Chair, at 12:35 PM by Zoom virtual meeting.

J. Rieschick stated because the CNE & IV Therapy Committee is conducting this public meeting by Zoom, she stated for the record the following information:

On March 14, 2022, the Board sent notice of the meeting for the CNE & IV Therapy Committee to all individuals who have requested notice of the Committee's meetings. Additionally, the notice and agenda were posted on the Board's website: **ksbn.kansas.gov**. The notice contains the meeting dial-in number and pin to allow the public to attend this meeting free of charge. The notice also advised individuals to contact the Board's office at 785-296-2967 if the individual does not have access to a computer.

Review of On-Site Packets: There is an onsite packet for Wesley Medical Long-Term Provider 5 Year renewal.

It was moved to accept the onsite packet as is. Motion #1 Gone/Sanderson Adopted.

Add/Rev. Agenda: It was moved to amend the agenda to change K.S.A. 60-12-104 to K.A.R. 60-12-104 and K.S.A 60-12-105 to K.A.R. 60-12-105. Motion #2 Owen/Aufdemberge Adopted.

Announcements: There were no announcements.

Minutes: The minutes from the December 14, 2021, CNE meeting were reviewed.

It was moved to approve the December 14, 2021, CNE minutes as written. Motion #3 Gone/Owen Adopted.

Unfinished Business:

IV-Therapy Task Force: C. Stephenson gave an overview of what the IV Taskforce discussed when they met on February 10, 2022. The taskforce will have a pool of test questions for the December 2022 meeting.

C.N.E. Regulations: C. Moreland gave in update on the revisions being made to the C.N.E. Regulations 60-9-105, 60-9-106, and 60-9-107. Regulation 60-9-105 and 60-9-107 are ready for the next steps. Regulation 60-9-106 needs to be more specific. The regulation must include a list of specific National Nursing Organizations approved for offering CNE. C. Moreland recommends to pick the National credentialing Organizations for APRNs. C. Moreland will need to revise 60-9-106 to list 8 of the National credentialing Organizations.

It was moved that the revision of 60-9-106 C.1 would include eight national nursing certificate organizations approved as offering CNE providers. Motion #4 Sanderson/Gone Adopted.

Delinquent Providers: C. Stephenson stated that on February 10, 2022, Summary Orders were sent to six Delinquent CNE Providers: Atkins Physical Therapy & Ergonomics LLC, Bailey Medical Services LLC, Clay County Medical Center, Kansas Department of Health & Environment, Parsons State Hospital & Training Center, and Perinatal ReSource. Two Summary Orders were returned in the mail as undeliverable. Of the six Delinquent CNE Providers none submitted a request for relief of the order. The approval status has officially been withdrawn from the six Delinquent CNE Providers.

Initial LTP Application: Kansas Department of Health and Environment – It was moved to approve the Initial Long-Term Provider application for Kansas Department of Health & Environment, pending receipt of the \$150.00 in delinquent annual fees by May 31, 2022. Motion #5 Burnett/Gone Adopted.

- Larned State Hospital – It was moved to approve the Long-Term Provider 5 Year Renewal Application for Larned State Hospital. Motion #8 Gone/Owen Adopted.
- LeadingAge Kansas – It was moved to approve the Long-Term Provider 5 Year Renewal Application for Leading Age Kansas, pending updated brochure MDS 3.0 to include language on being an approved provider with number of CNE contact hours. Motion #9 Aufdemberge/Burnett Adopted.
- Southwest Medical Center – It was moved to approve the Long-Term Provider 5 Year Renewal Application for Southwest Medical Center pending updated policy and procedures, sample evaluation, offering agenda, and bibliographies. Motion #10 Gone/Sanderson Adopted
