Discussion with our legal counsel was suggested to review if celtification could be an option over licensure and fmther discussion on the future vision for an LMHT work force.

2:1 Simulation Hours for Clinical:

J. Martin provided an update on the topic of 2:1 simulation hours for clinical. Informational literature was presented, and discussion occuned over quality and safety concerns and factors that need to be considered and continued discussion to follow.
