go live in Fall 2025.

Our office uses a system called MyLicense Office. This is essentially the licensing database as we know it. We received notification that system is going end of life as of June 30, 2027, which means that we need to be on the

new licensure system by that time.

Legislative Post Audit: Adrian reported that KSBN was selected for a legislative post audit

cybersecurity assessment. This will start on July 7, 2025 and will run

approximately two weeks.
