Dear Representative Landwehr,

During the 2017 Session, HB 2025, that was approved by the Governor, states the Board of Nursing shall submit a written report to the Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare and the House of Representatives Committee on Health and Human Services that includes an anonymous but individualized and itemized basis: the number of individuals who applied for reinstatement of a revoked license during the immediately preceding calendar year; the amount of money charged to each applicant; the number of such reinstatement applications that were granted and denied; and the basis given to deny an such reinstatement applications. During calendar year 2018 fourteen reinstatement applications were received from individuals in which their license had been revoked:

- 5 were approved
- 7 were denied
- 2 are pending (waiting on information from applicant or being worked by AAG)

I have attached a report that contains anonymous, but individual and itemized information that includes the money charged to each applicant, whether approved or denied, and the basis for approval or denial of reinstatement application.
