It was moved to accept the site visit report for Osawatomie State Hospital Mental Health Technician Program to grant approval to admit up to 60 students yearly among all three levels of the MHT program with a site visit to occur at the time of the first graduation. ## Major Curriculum Change Requests:

WU:

Washburn University BSN Program represented by Monica Scheibmeir, PhD, APRN, FAANP requests to add two pathophysiology courses NU 320 Pathophysiology I, 3 credit hours and NU 324 Pathophysiology II, 2 credit hours and to split the pharmacology content into two courses that are each 2 credit hours. NU 322 Pharmacology I with Lab (1 ½ credit hour didactic and ½ credit hour laboratory) and NU 326 Pharmacology II.. The total number of credit hours for the pre-licensure BSN program will increase from 123 to 124.

Rational for the change: Pathophysiology is currently being offered as a prerequisite to be taken after biology, anatomy and physiology and concurrent with chemistry. Because the courses must be taken in sequence, some students are unable to complete all of the prerequisite courses within 2 years of full-time study, thus extending their program of study by one semester.

It was moved to accept the Major Curriculum Change Request from Washburn University BSN Program to add two pathophysiology courses NU 320 Pathophysiology I, 3 credit hours and NU 324 Pathophysiology II, 2 credit hours and to split the pharmacology content into two courses that are each 2 credit hours. NU 322 Pharmacology I with Lab (1 ½ credit hour didactic and ½ credit hour laboratory) and NU 326 Pharmacology II. The total number of credit hours for the pre-licensure BSN program will increase from 123 to 124. Motion #9 LaMartina/White Adopted.

Cloud CCC:

Cloud County Community College ADN Program represented by Krista Bryant, MN, RN to offer a second option for completion of the ADN Program which would require the addition of two semesters for a generic ADN program with continuation of the existing LPN to ADN program. This would require approval to admit up to 18 students to the first two semesters and continue to admit LPNs for the second year, for a total of 36 second year students. This would increase our total number of nursing students from 36 to 54.

Rational for the change: The ADN program was originally formed as a joint program with North Central Kansas Technical School (Beloit campus). When NCKTC received full accreditation Cloud CCC saw a decline in enrollment.

It was moved to accept the Major Curriculum Change Request from Cloud County Community College ADN Program to offer a second option for completion of the ADN Program which would require the addition of two semesters for a generic ADN program with continuation of the existing LPN to ADN program. This would require approval to admit up to 18 students to the first two semesters and continue to admit LPNs for the second year, for a total of 36 second year students. This would increase total number of nursing students from 36 to 54. Motion #10 Weilert/LaMartina Adopted.

Annual Report Data: It was moved to reapprove the PN, ADN and BSN programs on full approval status through December 2017. Motion #11 Sander/Weilert Adopted.
