Task force update: Rex Patty reported on current INS standards. Standards changed in 2016 and regulation 60-16-104 was written from 2011 standards. Looking at changing verbiage to reference current standards and eliminating the list so as to not have to reopen every 5 years.

Feasibility of IV Therapy Integration/PN Curriculum
